- Tammy Magenta (GC Health Department) school audits to start in November. Review of TB testing, lead screenings, AFM (acute flaccid myelitis), bed bugs, lice and emergency preparedness (2019 local health department will develop local plan).
- Andrea Jones (GC Health Department) DOE will supply schools with doses of Narcan. From 2015-2017 - increase in overdoses and STD's despite education strategies. HIV testing can be done confidential for student 13 years and older.
- Dr. Kathleen Arcari (Neurobehavioral Health) "Anxiety in our Youth" - presentation of symptoms, diagnosis and treatment/intervention of common causes of anxiety in school age children.
